Now that the 2024 vegetable gardening season has started, I wanted to give an update on this ministry. In 2023, we had five people tending eleven 4'X20' raised bed plots. I am happy to report that in 2023, this group of folks raised and donated **395 pounds** of fresh produced! This produce was shared between the Northwood Food Pantry and the Ward Street Food Pantry. This was a great accomplishment and many needy families in the High point area benefited from the fresh produce. In many cases, this is the only time some families in need get fresh vegetables.

Now in 2024, we have seven people taking care of fourteen raised bed plots. We hope to exceed the 2023 year in raised produce.

Some background on this ministry: Covenant Church provides the growing beds, seeds, gardening tools, compost and mulch to grow vegetables for the families in need. All we ask is that you donate 75% of the produce grown to this ministry. The other 25% the growers get to keep. While we have all of our 14 raised beds spoken for this year, there is plenty of room to make more raised beds should others wish to be a part of the rewarding ministry. Also, if you do not have a green thumb, we are always in need of volunteers to help mow the non-used areas of the garden. The church provides a riding lawnmower, a push lawnmower and fuel for mowing.
